Find out about the proposed plans to improve safety on U.S. Route 460 between Commerce Drive and Leatherwood Lane in Bluefield. The project includes construction of offset left-turn lanes to improve sight distance at two intersections along Route 460 in the Town of Bluefield and includes the replacement of the traffic signal at each intersection.

Review the proposed project plans and the National Environmental Policy Act documentation in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or at VDOT's Bristol District Office located at 2111 Bonham Road in Bristol, 276-669-6151, 800-FOR-ROAD, or TTY/TDD 711.
