



Q12 On a scale of 1-to-5, rate how safe you feel in Downtown during the nighttime?





Q14 Do you feel the recommendations in the report are enough to reduce unsheltered houselessness in two years?










Q20 On a scale of 1-to-5, how would you rate cleanliness in Downtown?




