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

Evans Road Phase 1 Project Information

Scope

- Construct roadway & drainage improvements
 - Wider sidewalks
 - Curbs
 - Driveway approaches
 - Underground drainage system
- Total Funding: \$17.3 Million
 - Proposition A (Streets, bridges, and sidewalks): \$8.85 million
 - Proposition B (Drainage & Flood Control): \$8.45 million

Evans Road Ph 1 Project Purpose and Need



Existing Conditions

- Undersized drainage facilities in project limits.
- Minimal underground storm drainage infrastructure
- Narrow sidewalks
- Curbs nonstandard at varying heights.
- Two twelve-foot travel lanes in each direction.

Evans Road Phase 1 Project Purpose and Need



Proposed Improvements

Roadway

- New pavement
- New 6- to 8-foot-wide sidewalks
- New curbs & gutters to improve roadway drainage
- New pedestrian crossing at Evans & Masonwood

Drainage

- New underground storm sewer system
 - 2'-4' diameter underground pipes
 - New inlets
- Improved storm crossing at Roan Park

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Additional 7'X4' box culvert

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Evans Road Project Schedule

Project Schedule

- Currently in 70% Design
- Prior to construction:
 - Non joint bid Underground utility relocations
- **Estimated Construction Start**
 - Fall 2025
- Estimated Construction End
 - Fall 2027
