

# **Traffic and Safety Improvements**

- O1 Adds sidewalks for safe station access and eliminates sidewalk gaps
- 02 Improves traffic signal timing for people walking and biking
- 04 Improves pedestrian crossing conditions
- Adds infrastructure improvements in high injury areas including managing turns along the corridor



**U-Pass** is a special rider program available through partnerships with colleges and universities that provides unlimited bus rides on all regular <u>VIA service</u>, <u>Prímo</u>, <u>VIA Express</u>, and <u>VIA Link</u>, **FREE** each semester.

**OBTAINING YOUR U-PASS:** The U-PASS is available by downloading the VIA goMobile+ app onto your smart phone and creating an account using the email address associated with your college/university. Once signed in, your U-PASS will automatically show up within minutes.

Eligible students, faculty or staff who do not have access to a mobile device, can simply show an Alamo Colleges ID to the bus operator when boarding.


Factors influencing station locations at or near existing VIA bus stops





# How transit is funded in Texas

In 1973, the Texas Legislature authorized up to 1% local sales tax for transit (MTA).

In 1977, San Antonio voters approved the creation of the first MTA in Texas, VIA, funded by a 1/2 cent (0.5%) sales tax.




# **Proposed VIA Rapid Silver Line**


STATION FOR CENTER-RUNNING LANE


