## Why is the proposed Silver Line needed?




The proposed VIA Rapid Silver Line project expands transportation choices for residents along the East and West sides of San Antonio. The project would also facilitate continued economic growth and connectivity to jobs, education, recreational activities, goods and services, medical care and other essentials of daily life.


Calculated based on population and employment estimates within ½ mile of potential station areas using Transportation Analysis Zone data from AAMPO's travel demand



Prímo 100 travels from Centro Plaza and Ellis Alley Park & Ride to the Medical Center Transit Center. The service runs daily, with frequent service every 15 minutes during peak times. Fare is the same as VIA's regular bus service and daily and monthly passes are accepted.

#### **VIA PRIMO FEATURES**

- Transit signal priority to speed up travel times
- Wheelchair self-restraint (60-foot buses only)
- Bikes on board (60-foot buses only)
- LCD information display
- Real-time arrival information along route
