## Improved Access

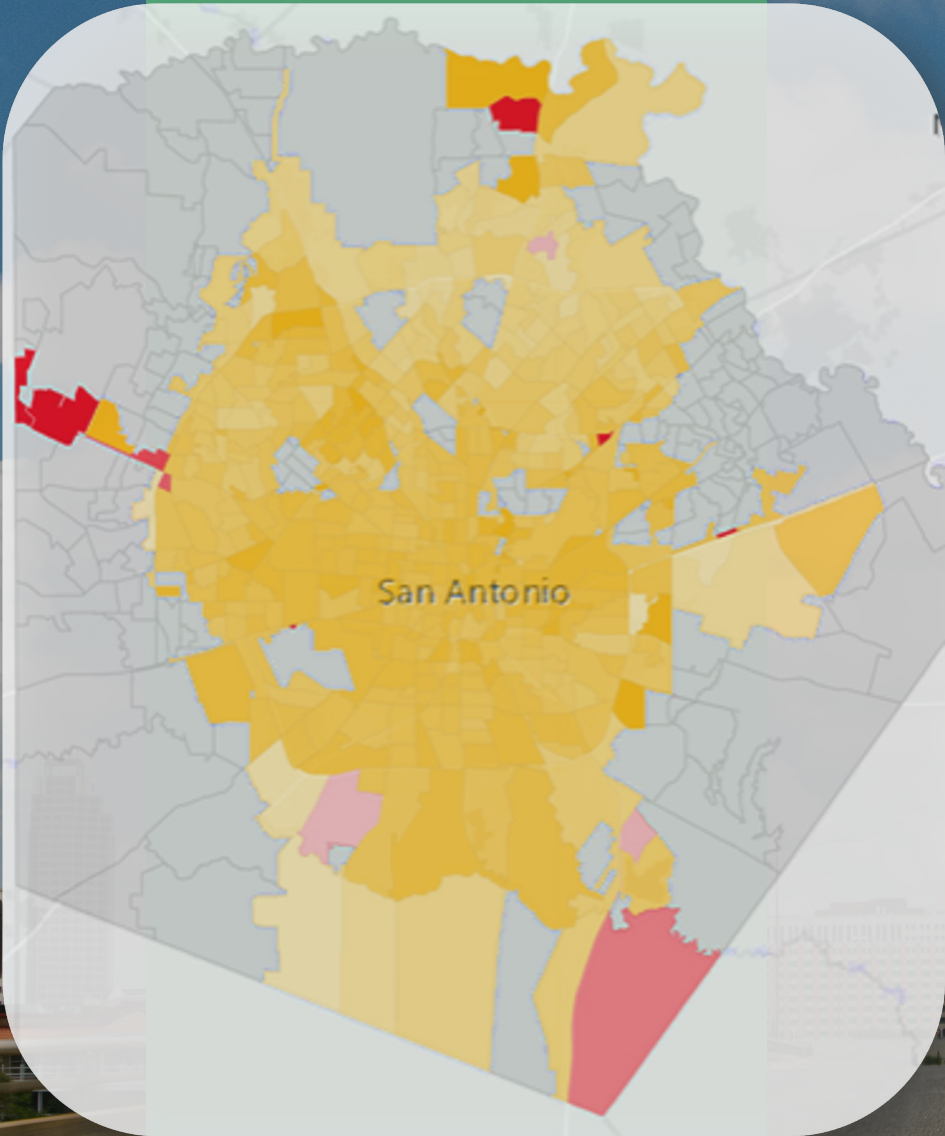
Improve transit access between residential areas and job centers

- Pay before you board for faster boarding times



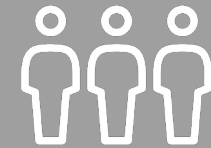
## Simplifies your trip

- Delivers access to key destinations

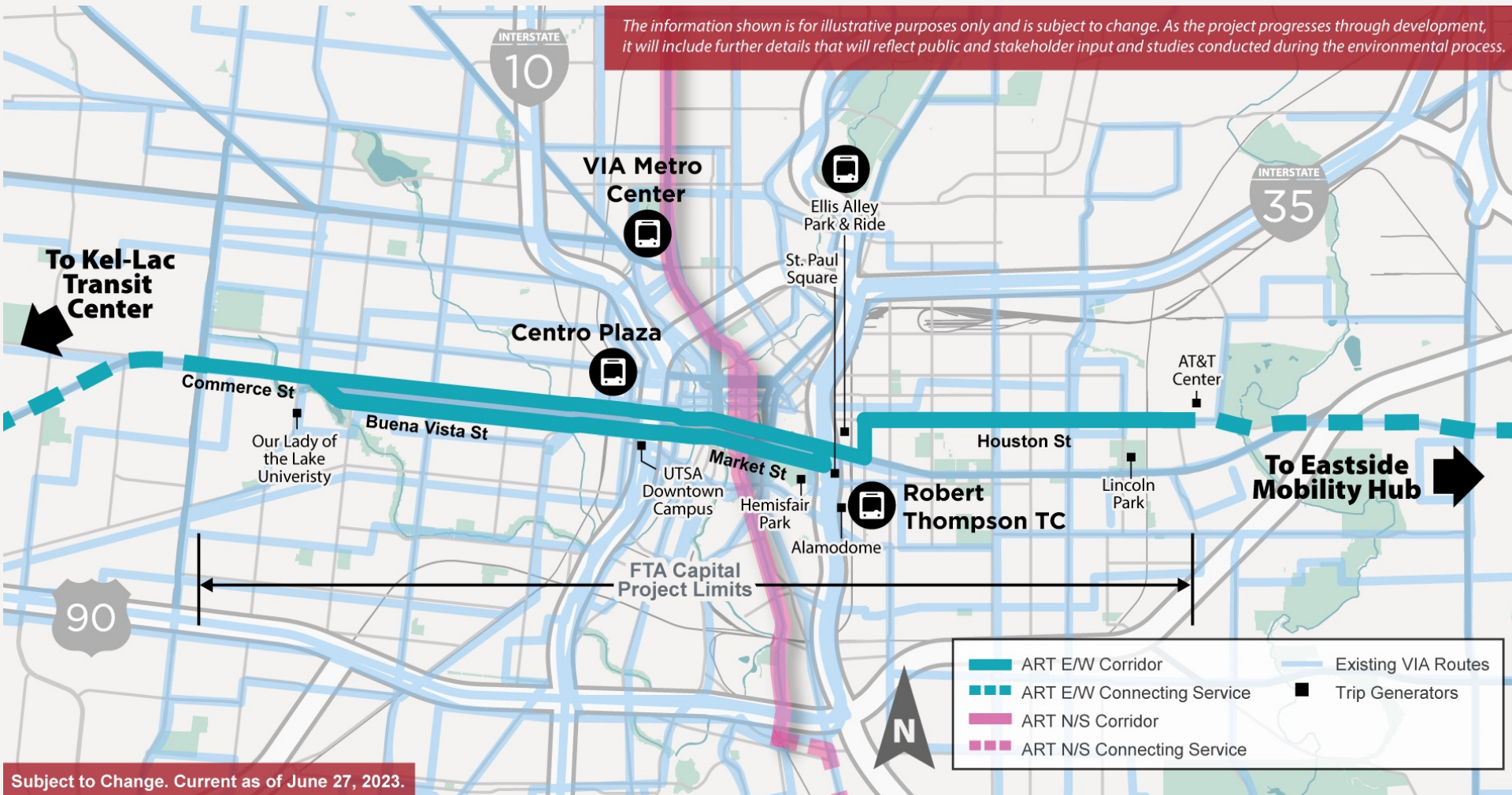

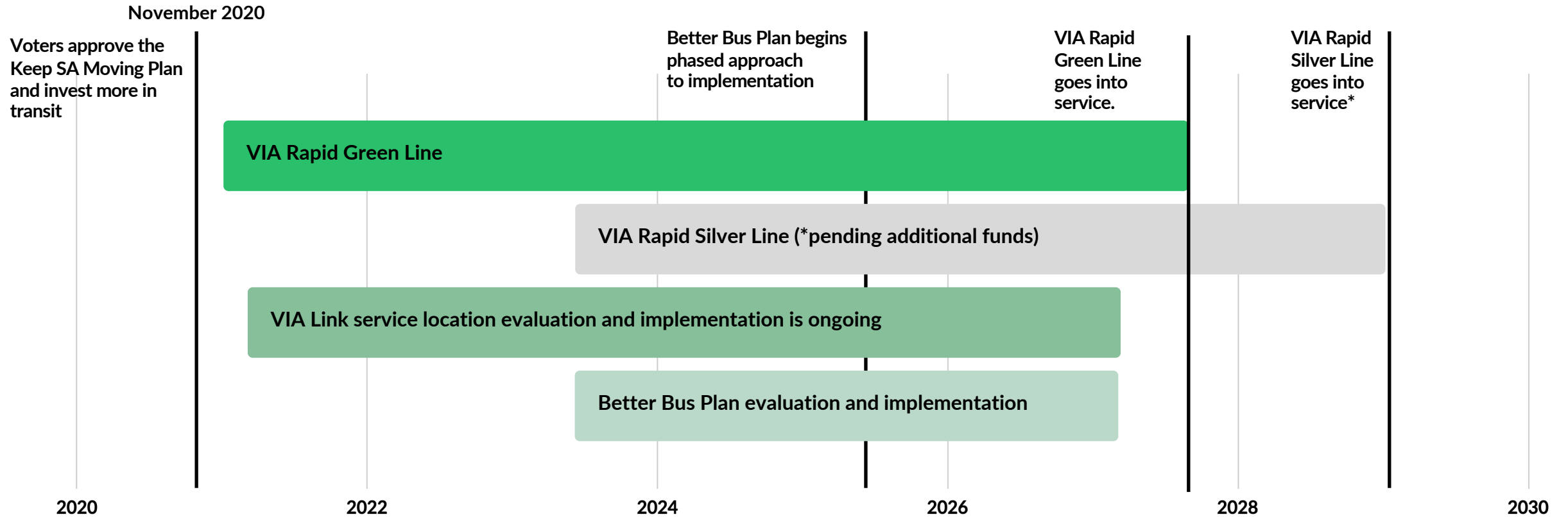


STATION FOR CENTER-RUNNING LANE



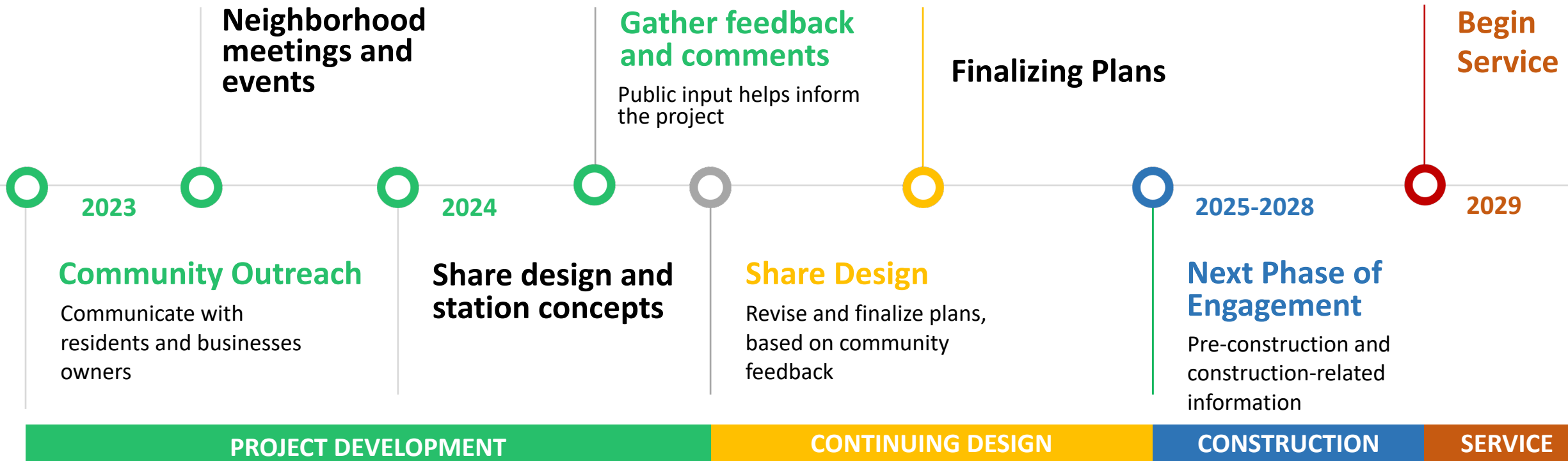
