

# North Highline Catalog of Community Requests

January 2021

## Introduction

This document summarizes all of the community requests that King County has heard during public engagement for the Catalog of Community Requests from August to December 2020. In cases where there were many requests under the same category, such as sidewalks, such requests have been grouped together at the end of this document. The County will spend January and February evaluating the requests and feedback. Then, a new round of community conversations will begin in order to establish priorities and determine costs and feasibility.

## What is the Catalog of Community Requests?

The Catalog of Community Requests is the initial list of services, programs, facilities, and capital improvements that community members have indicated they would like to see implemented in their area. The Catalog of Community Requests is the first phase in the process of creating the Community Needs List.

## What is a Community Needs List?

A Community Needs List (K.C.C. 2.16.055) is a list of potential community-identified services, programs, facilities, and capital improvements that King County could implement in unincorporated King County. It is created after evaluation and prioritization of the Catalog of Community Requests by the King County Departments and the community that created the request. A separate Community Needs List will be created for each of the Community Service Areas as well as each of the five urban unincorporated areas of Skyway-West Hill, North Highline, East Federal Way, Fairwood, and East Renton.
