LONG RANGE

It provides a long-term vision for the County and impacts development and government decisions for 10 to 20 years.






While long range, the Comprehensive Plan is meant to change and adapt to the needs of the County community.

WATER

How can you be involved?

LISTENING SESSIONS



Listening Sessions will consist of one-on-one and small group conversations that will take place throughout the project, either virtually or in person, at key locations across the County. Participants will have the chance to share their perspectives on challenges and opportunities in Alamosa County.

OPEN HOUSES



At these technology-supported Open Houses, the community will have the opportunity to visualize and evaluate the visions, choices and opportunities for Alamosa County. Open Houses will take place throughout the project at key locations across the County to ensure as much participation as possible.

ONLINE QUESTIONNAIRES



Online Questionnaires will replicate information shared and questions asked at in-person events. In total, the public will have the opportunity to respond to three questionnaires throughout the process that address key topics in the Comprehensive Plan update.

COMMUNITY CHOICES WORKSHOPS



The Community Choices workshop series offers community members the chance to provide input on key themes in the draft Plan. There will be interactive activities to make envisioning Alamosa County's future fun.

COMMUNITY POP-UP EVENTS



Pop up information stations will be utilized at existing community events and in public spaces such as recreation centers and libraries, for County staff and Project Partners to collect feedback and share information about the Plan in a fun and informal setting!

ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETINGS



Community Advisory Committee Meetings will consist of community leaders, business owners, and organization representatives that have volunteered to be a sounding board for ideas developed through the plan update process. There will be 9 AC meetings in total.

HIGH SCHOOL ENGAGEMENT



High-school students from Alamosa County will help define the direction of the Comprehensive Plan update through small group work sessions. Students will facilitate interviews and distribute questionnaires around the County.

COMMUNITY SHOWCASE



When can you participate?

The Imagine Alamosa Comprehensive Plan update is defined by three phases, each spanning several months. Every phase is guided by an overarching set of engagement events meant to achieve different levels of public impact, paired with community advisory committee meetings. At each stage, there will be opportunities for residents and community members to provide input on all elements of the plan update in English and Spanish. Public Review of the Draft Plan occurring in Phase 3 marks the final forum for community feedback.

Phase 1: Setting the Foundation

Phase Summary

This initial phase is all about laying the groundwork for the Comprehensive Plan Update by hosting conversations with people in the community. We will host a series of one-on-one or small group listening sessions, that will take place virtually or by phone. Additionally, there will be a chance to meet in person during the kick-off week throughout the County. An online questionnaire will also be open for further discussion.

This phase offers the community opportunities to get involved, share what they love, and learn about ways to stay engaged throughout the process.

Phase 2: Defining the Direction

Phase Summary

This next phase is all about taking what we already heard from the community and diving deeper, engaging residents and elected officials in the process. We will host a series of visioning outreach events that will feature interactive workshops on shared values and big ideas facing Alamosa County. We will also organize a series of public workshops that utilize electronic polling, hands-on technology, and interactive discussions to establish the values and vision for the County.

Our goal in this phase is to learn more what community members value in Alamosa County along with a better understanding of some of the County's key challenges and opportunities.

Deepening the Dialogue...

- What types of development would you like to see in Alamosa County, and where?
- How can commercial development be balanced with maintaining the character and environment of Alamosa County?
- How important is preserving agricultural land to you, and what strategies should be used to support local farmers?
- How can we make transportation in Alamosa County more accessible and environmentally friendly?









Phase 3: Realizing the Plan

Phase Summary

Based on all analysis, input, and work completed up to this point, we will assemble a Draft Plan for review and refinement. We will present key components from the document at open house events throughout the County and provide a version of the document online for public review. During this stage, we will document how we've considered and addressed public feedback. The initial policy outline will cover goals and policies, a Land Use Map indicating future land use and conservation plans, strategies for managing growth, services, infrastructure, and potential expansion into urban areas.

- Did we address your feedback and concerns?
- Are there any specific concerns or issues you feel are not adequately addressed in the Draft Plan?
- What do you think are the strengths and weaknesses of the draft plan overall?
- Are there any concerns or suggestions regarding the proposed strategies for managing growth within the community?
