## TRAFFIC ALERT

The N.C. Department of Transportation will temporarily close a portion of E. Thurman Road between U.S. 70 and Sweet Bay Drive starting Thursday night, Oct. 6, at 10 p.m. until Friday morning, Oct. 7, at 6 a.m. The maps on the back side of this flier shows the location of the road closure and detours for travelers using E. Thurman between U.S. 70 and Old Cherry Point Road. This work is part of the U.S. 70 Improvements in James City Project.

This closure is necessary to accommodate sewer and water line installation. Temporary signs will be in place to alert motorists of the road closure and the detour route.

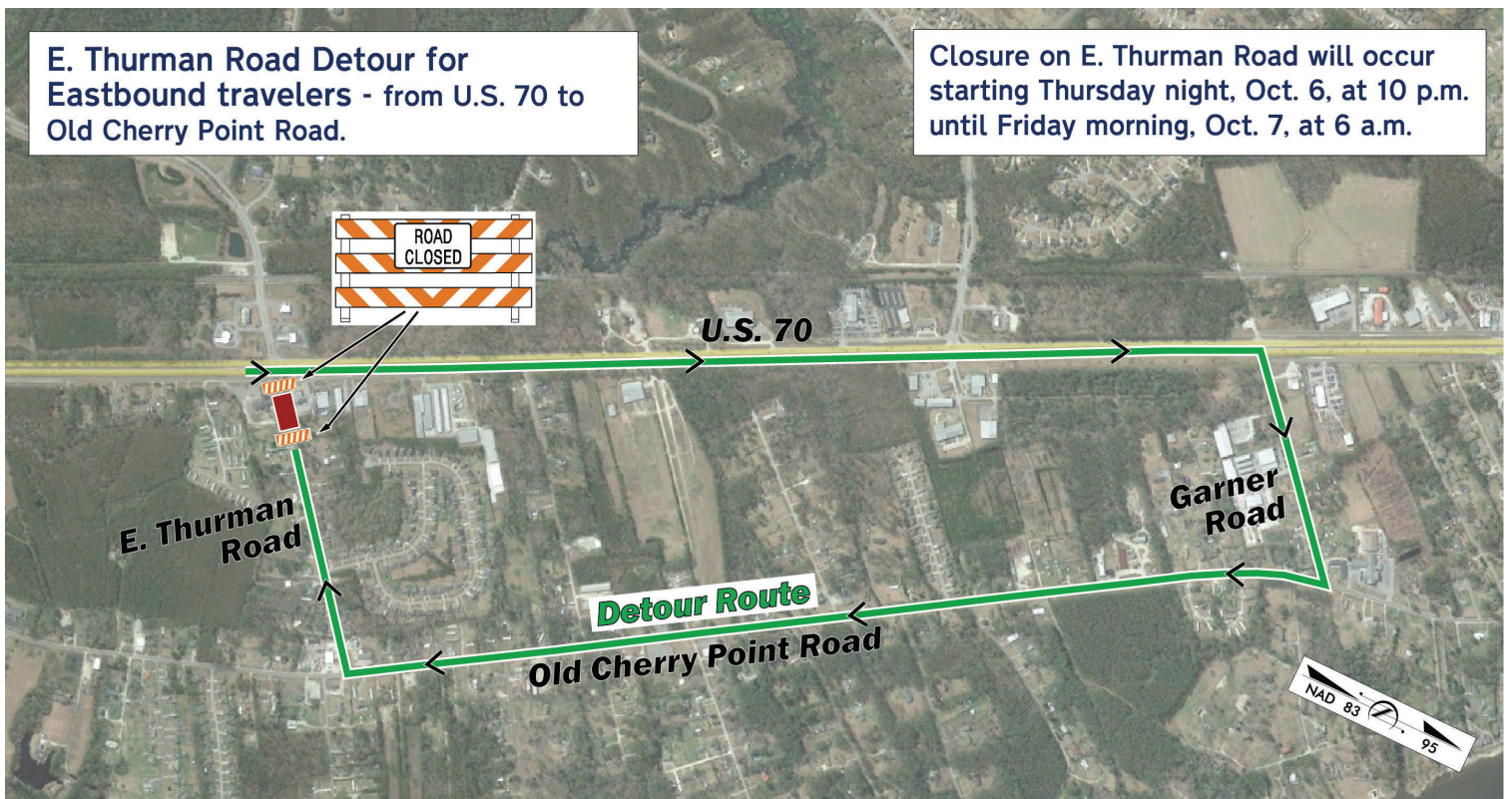
