What is your vision for Guilford County?

Guilford County has been awarded \$104 million in federal funding. This funding is part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA).

We need your help in deciding how to allocate the funds! Our primary goal is to support residents affected by COVID-19. This is also a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to invest in the county's future. Your voice is important in creating a vision for Guilford County.

What can the funds be used for?

Addressing Negative Economic Impacts

Guilford County can use ARPA funds to address negative economic impacts to:

- workers
- families
- small businesses
- nonprofits
- other affected industries

We can also re-hire public sector workers.

Public Health Response

To support the public health response to COVID-19, Guilford County can:

- Fund COVID-19 mitigation efforts, such as contact tracing and vaccination programs.
- Cover medical expenses and mental health treatment for those affected by COVID-19.
- Pay for certain public health and safety staff.

Providing Premium Pay for Essential Workers

Essential workers have been providing crucial care and services throughout the pandemic. This has been at the risk of their health and the health of their families. Guilford County



can use ARPA funds to offer monetary support to these essential workers. We can distribute this money retroactively back to January 27, 2020.

Water and Sewer Infrastructure

Guilford County can also improve water and sewer infrastructure. This could include:



- making necessary investments to improve access to clean drinking water.
- improving or expanding wastewater and stormwater infrastructure to communities with limited or no service.



Broadband Infrastructure

Guilford County can use the ARPA funds to Improve Broadband Infrastructure. We would focus on providing underserved locations with new or expanded broadband access.



We want to invest these funds in projects that center community voices in decision-making. Our goal is to:

- Build on a foundation of existing County and regional efforts
- Maximize funding by combining efforts with other projects and sources of funding.
- Focus on sustainability with one-time uses or by establishing a path to sustainability.



ARPA Ineligible Uses



Deposits to Rainy Day funds or financial services. This is because these would create savings rather than respond to pandemic recovery needs.



General infrastructure spending outside of those in the eligible uses.



Deposits into defined pension funds unless they are for employees whose wages are an eligible use.



Legal settlements or judgements except for any services responding to the public health emergency.



Funds cannot be used to pay debt incurred before March 3, 2021.



Non-federal matching funds for federal programs.
