About the Project

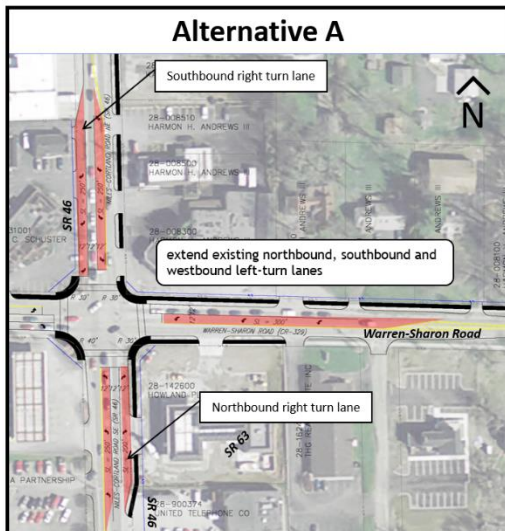

Proposed Project:

Improve SR 46/Warren Sharron Road Intersection by:

- Constructing northbound and southbound right-turn lanes
- Extending the existing northbound, southbound and westbound left-turn lanes
- Reconstructing the traffic signal
- Installing ADA accessible pedestrian accommodations

Purpose: Improve Safety

Temporary & Minor New Permanent Rights-of-way are required.

Maintenance of Traffic:

- Minimum of one lane of traffic in each direction maintained
- Access to commercial, residential properties will be maintained
- Pedestrian traffic maintained via existing sidewalks and detour routes
