The master plan will provide inspiration, a clear vision, and an actionable guide for Buncombe County's parks, recreation facilities, greenways, trails, and open spaces.




SYSTEMWIDE MASTER PLAN THREE EFFORTS IN ONE



- Parks and Recreation Department is leading this effort with the assistance of multiple County departments, partner agencies, and stakeholders.
- Development of a Comprehensive Master Plan represents a monumental milestone in the history of the Department.
- ✓ With a horizon of priorities and needs over the next 20+ years, this effort will have specific actions for Department staff for immediate implementation, a focused strategic plan for the next 5-years, and long-term recommendations for 20+ years.





Enka Heritage Trail

- 1.75 miles total
- Preliminary engineering phase
- Environmental hazards mitigation
- Changing termini due to feasibility issues

Woodfin Greenway

- Comprised of two (2) projects/ segments:
 - Hwy 251/Riverside Drive Section
 - Beaverdam Creek Section
- 4.5 miles total
- Hwy 251 section ROW in 2024
- Beaverdam Creek section in preliminary engineering

- ✓ Goal: Conserve 20% of the County's total acreage by 2030 (84,096 acres).
 - Protect natural environments that support clean water, provide habitat for wildlife, offer nature-based recreation, and provide picturesque rural views will be conserved.


